Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: School Arrangements from Thursday 4th November - During National Restrictions

I am writing to confirm the modifications to school life starting from today because of the new period of National Restrictions (referred to by some as Lockdown 2) which lasts until 2nd December. The Government has made it clear that schools should remain open and providing staffing levels remain adequate, this is my intention and all students should continue to attend school unless they are required to self-isolate or are unwell.

I am afraid that all the extra-curricular clubs that we started will stop and all students will be expected to go straight home when they leave school unless they have a detention, which will continue as it is an important element of the school's behaviour management system.

I must also remind parents that **all students** are required to have a facemask to wear in school in designated areas and should not travel to or from school in vehicles with people from other households. If they use public transport they must follow the appropriate guidance.

Too many students are arriving at school without a facemask and we are struggling to be able to buy enough to provide them with one. Please remember that the face masks are worn in order to keep everyone safe so I would appreciate your support in ensuring that your child has one that they can wear at school.
